DADH 2020 Poster Guidelines

If your poster was accepted into the conference, please follow the guidelines below for your final submissions.

- I. Submit your poster as a digital PDF file
 - (1) The poster should be in .pdf file format, no larger than 15 MB, and with a resolution of at least 300 dpi. Please consider the poster's visual appearance and legibility as it would appear on a computer screen.
 - (2) The poster should include: title, author information (name, position/organization, contact email), and main points of the research. You are otherwise free to present the content in whatever way you believe best showcases your research. Due to the conference's international audience, we recommend you provide an English component for your poster's content.
- II. Submit a 2-minute video file containing your poster presentation
 - (1) The video should be in a common video file format, no larger than 200 MB. There are no restrictions on the presentation style of your video. However, we recommend that it contains an introduction of you and/or your research team, and explains the research content of your poster. A speaker providing sound narration is recommended. Due to the conference's international audience, providing an English presentation or translation would be ideal.
